- Under no circumstances is the code of the style you have purchased (original or modified) permitted to be distributed to other parties.


- Exceptions will only be made with written permission from vbskinworks.com. All copyright notices must remain in the templates unless a branding free license is purchased.

How do I install the style?

Before you make changes to your board it is always a good idea to back up your database first.

1. Extract the zip files to a folder on your computer.
2. Upload the included image folder to your forums /images directory (ex: forum/images).
3. Login to your Admincp in your vBulletin forum and click on **Styles and Templates** to expand the menu.
- 4 . In the expanded menu click on **Download / Upload Styles**, a new page will load.



5. In the new page look for **Import Style XML File**. Click on browse and point it to the MT.lite or MT.dx.xml file that came with this style and import it following the diagram below. **Repeat the process for the skin_name_fluid/fixd.xml file included in the package making sure to select the MT style you imported first as the "Parent Style".**
